- Walk-in clinics from 9:30—11:00 AM at the Shelburne Falls Senior Center on the fourth Tuesday of every month.
- Walk-in clinics for any resident of Hawley, Charlemont, Monroe, Gill, Buckland, Conway, Leyden, Shelburne and Deerfield: Conway Town Hall the first Friday of every month from 9 - 11 AM, Deerfield Town Hall every Wednesday from 10 AM—2 PM.
- Assisting residents of any member town with medication management, assessment, and monitoring of health conditions
- Preventative and diagnostic health screenings.
- Community vaccination clinics and home vaccination to home-bound residents in need.
- Individual help for people living with chronic health conditions.
- Mercury thermometer and sharps disposal and container exchange (collaboration with the Franklin County Solid Waste Mgmt. Program).
- Skin testing for residents and town employees at risk for Tuberculosis.
