- Minutes from May 10, 2018 meeting were unanimously approved.
- Review proposal for fixed wireless service to Shelburne Falls from Christopher Gray, Hilltown Networks.
 - Reviewed 4 page proposal entitled "Roof Access at Memorial Hall for Last-Mile Wireless Network Services"
 - Proposal is to get access to MassBroadband 123 network at Memorial Hall, distribute to customers, as an alternative to currently available services (e.g. Comcast)
 - o Requires
 - i. roof-mounted 6 foot pole with 16 inch antenna.
 - ii. 19 inch dish to connect.
 - iii. cable from MB123 closet to outside of building up to roof
 - iv. plans to provide internet and phone service to customers, TV in future
 - v. Access, contract, removal plan, insurance (see proposal for details)
 - Proposal is to get access to MassBroadband 123 network at Memorial Hall, distribute to customers, and give town hall free business class 5mb down/5mb up service.
 - Committee would like to get information on how this service compares to current internet plan for Memorial Hall. Need to talk with town administrator to get details.
- Report on 9/6/2018 Comcast/MBI presentation.
 - Mike Duffy was at the meeting, as was Lt. Governer, VP of Comcast
 - Shelburne had 213 additional customers added (+20%) as a result of the Comcast expansion to serve 96% of town.
 - Head of MBI considers the project done.

- The proposed expansion of Colrain Fiber Network to Shelburne was discussed.
 - M.D. presented an inter-governmental agreement (IGA) between Alford and West Stockbridge, as a model for Shelburne and Colrain to use.
 - Kevin Fox is the town administrator of Colrain
 - Potential cost to Shelburne is \$85k
 - MD will edit the IGA as a draft for Shelburne and Colrain
