

## Message from the Board of Health - October 14, 2020

The Mohawk Drive-Thru Flu Clinic is scheduled for Saturday October 17 from 10 a.m. - Noon at Mohawk Trail Regional High School with a raindate of Sunday October 18th. Please come prepared to help the clinic run smoothly and quickly. We ask that residents wear a mask, bring your insurance card, and the two forms available on the town of Shelburne website or requested at the Arms or Buckland libraries (you should fill these out prior to arrival). Please dress so that your upper arm is easily accessible, or for babies we will need access to the upper thigh. As a reminder all school aged children are required to have the flu vaccine by December 31, 2020

The Board of Health is making the following Halloween trick or treating recommendations. Maintain Social Distancing, wear face coverings, limit your trick or treating to your neighborhood and close relatives. If a street looks busy move on to another location. For those distributing candy use a table to put distance between yourself and the children, wear gloves and masks, distribute pre wrapped goodies and don't allow children to put their hands in a bowl. Do not encourage gatherings indoors or out. **Have Fun and Stay Safe!**
